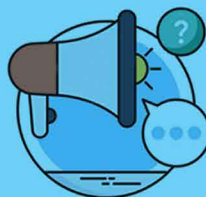

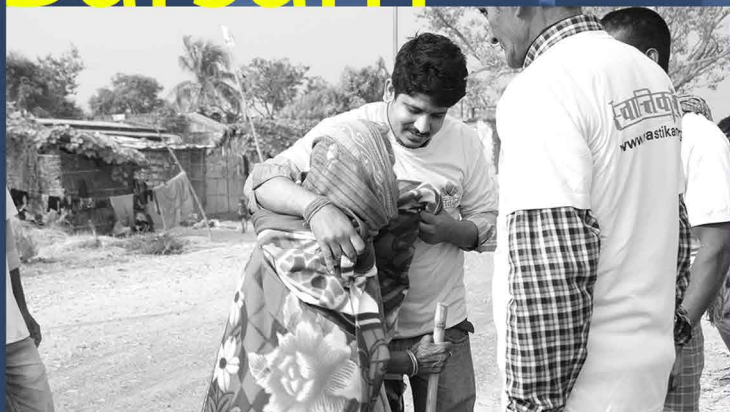

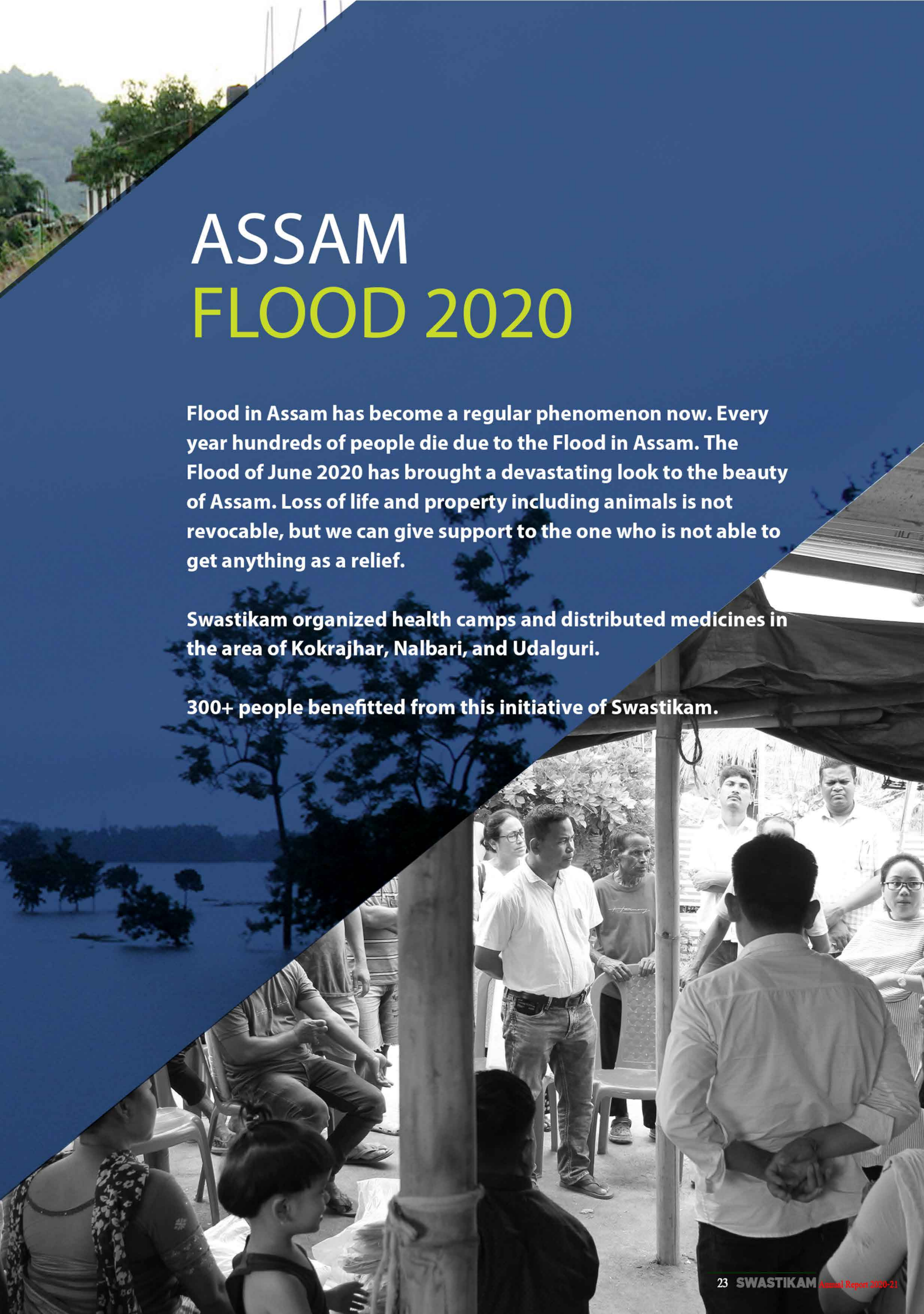


# ASSAM FLOOD 2020
